## **Key Knowledge and Big Ideas:**

# **Big Idea and Powerful Knowledge:**

- 1. The Big Idea is Music, and the key focus is on describing the influence of singers and musicians, changes an developments in music and the impact on popular culture.
- 2. Key vocabulary and structures are revisited from KS4, including using a variety of tenses and a range of vocabulary.
- 3. Students are also supported to master key grammatical concepts such as the future tenses and using infinitive structures.
- 4. Common misconceptions identified from KS4, such as using irregular verbs in a variety of pronouns, are addressed through consistent practice, hinge questions and low-stakes retrieval practice quizzing.
- 5. Students revisit employing connectives, sequencers and time markers to extend their sentences.
- 6. Pupils develop their knowledge of advanced, analytical and idiomatic language.

- 1. Formative assessment through:
  - Retrieval practice quizzing (Do Now)
  - Questioning in lessons

  - Paper 1 (Listening, Reading, Translation) which assesses students on the topic of Music but also other A Level topics.
