Minimum wage rise starts this month

The minimum wage increases this month. The new rates are:

	Rate from April 2022	Current rate (April 2021 to March 2022)	Increase
National Living Wage	£9.50	£8.91	6.6%
21-22 Year Old Rate	£9.18	£8.36	9.8%
18-20 Year Old Rate	£6.83	£6.56	4.1%
16-17 Year Old Rate	£4.81	£4.62	4.1%
Apprentice Rate	£4.81	£4.30	11.9%
Accommodation Offset	£8.70	£8.36	4.1%

Marks and Spencer are to raise their minimum pay for staff to £10 an hour to match other retailers such as Aldi, Lidl, Morrisons and Sainsburys. Those working in a London M and S store will get £11.25 an hour.

Business and Finance apprenticeships prove the most popular

FE Times reports that recruiters the <u>Talent People</u> have analysed apprenticeship data from <u>GetMyFirstJob</u> and revealed the top 10 most popular apprenticeships of 2021. Traditional careers in Business and Finance are proving to be the most attractive along with Digital and Tech roles.

- Generated £10.1bn in revenue
- Seen employment rise by 13%
- Created 6,000 new jobs
- 52,700 people working in cyber.

Flexible apprenticeships

The new flexible apprenticeships announced by the government are designed to create jobs for people in sectors which boost the economy such as the construction and creative sectors. The NHS and the BBC are amongst employers who will offer these flexible apprenticeships, which aim to give apprentices experience across a number of placements. 1,500 placements are to be made available.

Busy Bees are seeking apprentices across the UK

700 new apprentices are being sought by Busy Bees childcare nurseries. Those successful will be working towards a Level 3 qualification in Childcare and Education and be offered a permanent job on completion of their apprenticeship. Progression to become a Level 5 Early Years Practitioner is also possible.
