Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please see an updated itinerary of events that your child will be taking part in the Lessons from Auschwitz Project. This also includes the flight details and transport to/from St Marks.

The LFA Project is made up of four parts. **All parts are compulsory.**

1) Orientation seminar – Sunday 1st February 13:00 – 17:00 at The Regent High School, Chalton Street, London NW1 1RX

Participants examine pre-war Jewish life, hear in-person testimony from a Holocaust survivor and discuss the unique issues of preparing for a Holocaust-related site visit.

2) One-day visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial and Museum – Wednesday 4th February from Gatwick Airport. Check-in: 04:30. Student should arrive at St Mark's for 03:30 for a taxi to collect them. Expected return to school that evening of 23:00.

Participants tour authentic sites and museum exhibits with both a local guide and a trained LFA educator who leads group discussions.

3) Follow-Up Seminar – Tuesday 10th February, 15:00 – 17:30 on Zoom (Registration opens at 14:45).

A half-day seminar for participants to reflect on the visit, explore the contemporary relevance of the Holocaust and devise practical ideas for their Next Steps.

4) Next Steps – deadline is Wednesday 25th March.

Participants become "Ambassadors" for the Trust by completing a project of their choosing aimed at disseminating in their schools and communities the lessons they have learned.
