SCHOOL VISIT TO The Globe Theatre

I am writing to inform you that, as your child has been identified as a High Potential Achiever or High Prior Attainer, they have been selected to attend two trips in March.

Trip 1: Globe Theatre Interactive Drama Workshop and Tour

The first trip is to The Globe Theatre to take part in an Interactive Drama Workshop and a tour of the Globe Theatre on 2nd March 2026. This workshop will be run by staff members from The Globe Theatre Company and will give students an insight into how Shakespeare created his plays.

The workshop will take place from 12.15pm–2.00pm. We will be using public transport to travel to and from The Globe Theatre. We will be leaving school at 11.15am and arriving back at school at approximately 3.10pm.

Students must be in full school uniform for this trip and will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Students who are in receipt of free school meals will receive a packed lunch.

Trip 2: Romeo and Juliet Performance at The Globe Theatre

Following on from the workshop, your child will have the opportunity to watch Romeo and Juliet live at The Globe Theatre on Tuesday 3rd March. The performance will run from 7.00pm–8.30pm, but we will be aiming to arrive at 6.15pm to arrange ticket collection.

Again, we will be using public transport to get to and from The Globe Theatre, leaving St Mark's at 5.15pm and arriving back at school at approximately 9.35pm. Students must be in full school uniform for this trip. All students are also welcome to bring their own refreshments to consume during the interval of the show.

As this trip is outside of usual school hours, students will need to bring a contactless bank card or Oyster/ZIP card that they can use to tap in and tap out at Mitcham Eastfields and Blackfriars stations for travel to and from The Globe Theatre.

With parental consent, students are welcome to get off the train on the return journey from Blackfriars towards Mitcham Eastfields and make their own way home. Please email me at bmoggridge@stmarks.anthemtrust.uk if you would like your child to do this. All other students will be brought back to school and dismissed from there.

Please note that students are welcome to go home at the end of the school day on 3rd March, but they must be back in school by 5.00pm, where they should meet Mr Moggridge and Mr Lewis in main reception. Students are also welcome to stay in school from 3.15pm–5.00pm, where they can use the library or attend an enrichment club.

If you are yet to complete a general consent form for your child, please complete the permission slip on the reverse of this letter and return it to Mr Moggridge by Friday 20th February.
