### **Year 11- Visit to The Globe Theatre – Romeo and Juliet**

I am writing to inform you that the English Department are taking all Year 11 students to The Globe Theatre on **Tues 3<sup>rd</sup> March** to see a production of Romeo and Juliet. There is **no cost** for the tickets, and this is a fantastic opportunity for all students to see a production of the GCSE set text in preparation for their exams in the summer.

The performance will be from 14.00- 15.30. We will be using public transport to get to and from The Globe, **leaving St Mark's at 12.15pm and arriving back at school at approximately 16.40pm.**

Students must be in full school uniform for this trip and should wear a warm, waterproof coat as we have tickets in the standing section of the theatre (which has a great view!) but is not under a roof.

Students should also bring a water bottle and packed lunch with them – if your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided for them. If you would like this provision, please can you tick the box on the permission slip on the reverse of this letter. All students are also welcome to bring their own refreshments to consume during the interval of the show.

Finally, students can be dismissed directly from The Globe Theatre, with parent permission. Please indicate on the return form if you would like your child to make their own way home from The Globe Theatre, otherwise students will return to school with a member of staff and be dismissed from there.
