## Other important protocols regarding the virtual Year 13 Subjects Parents' and Carers' Evening

We would like to establish some ground rules so that all participants are following the same protocol to ensure all video calls are as safe and as effective as possible. The virtual appointments must be attended by the parent/carer. Your child is encouraged to attend with you however they cannot attend on their own. By you joining the video call, as a parent/ carer, you agree to take responsibility for ensuring the following protocols are adhered to:

- For full engagement and interaction, we encourage you to enable both your microphone and your camera for the appointments. If you do turn your camera on, please ensure you have a neutral background with no one else in view or able to view your screen. Please ensure there are no inappropriate photos, pictures or wording/logos in your background.
- If you live with others, please do make them aware of the times for the virtual parents' evening so that you are not disturbed and there are no distractions. Try to avoid other people walking into your camera shot or background.
- You should be appropriately dressed as you would be for a real-life face to face parents' meeting.
- Keeping your camera on is not compulsory and so you are free to have your camera off if you so wish.
- No conversations should be recorded.
- Please try to be on time as the slot times are not flexible at all and will start/finish exactly on time automatically. The teacher is not able to extend this. All appointments have a 6-minute time limit.
- St Marks's is often commended for the very positive, constructive relationships between staff and parents, and it is important that this continues. Therefore, please note that in the extremely unlikely event of verbal abuse, staff will end the conversation and refer the matter to the Senior Leadership Team.

If you do not have access to the internet, please contact Mrs Haider and we will be happy to add appointments on your behalf and support with arrangements for the evening. Similarly, if you have any further questions, please feel free to contact us at any time.
